


Silent Letters

Context:

The English Language is full of words that contain silent letters. Even older students can have a hard time remembering how to spell them. This fun and interactive activity has been designed to reinforce the learning of some awkward words.

Preparation:

Print out the A4 sheets.

Glue the two halves of the Game Board together and if possible, laminate it. We have provided a blank game board for students to make a new version of the game, with their own clues, pictures and rules.

HOW TO PLAY:

This game is for either two or four players (two against two). You will need the Game Board, a pencil each, a Record Sheet each, dice and counters.

1. Players/teams take turns rolling the dice and moving their counter along the board. When they land on a clue they have to guess the word and then write it onto their Record Sheet.
2. Depending on the ability of the players, you can provide them with the Word List. If you choose not to use this, you will still need it at the end of the game to check spellings.
3. The first player to reach "home" gets 5 points. When this happens, all players must check the spellings of the words on their Record Sheets, using the Word List. They get one point for every correctly spelt word. The player/team with the most points wins the game.

Learning Outcomes:

Students will have practised and improved their spelling of some tricky words that contain silent letters. If you have found further learning outcomes please share them by emailing collaborate@mantralingua.com.



Silent Letters Game - Snakes and Ladders


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(This is the top half of the board. Cut along the dotted line and glue to the bottom half.)
